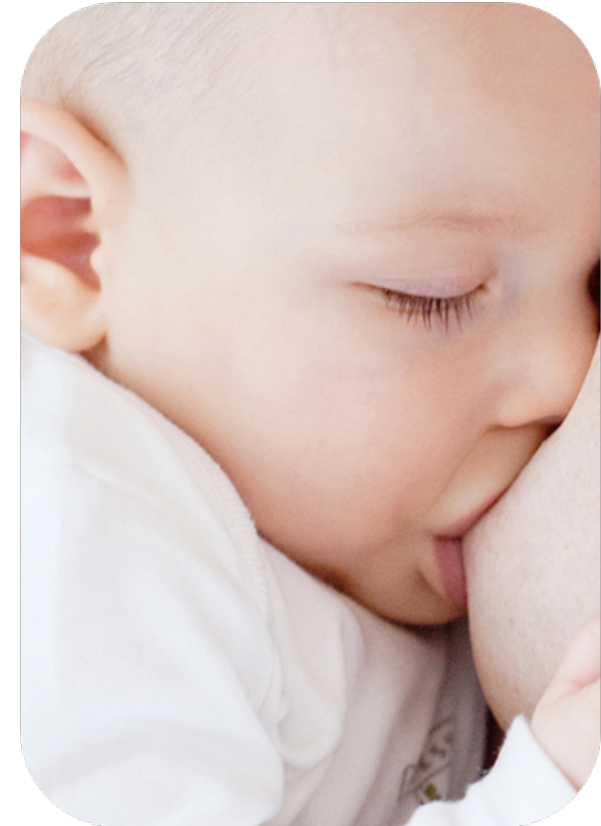

**Paracetamol** and **ibuprofen** do not cause any problem in breastfeeding

If an **antibiotic** is necessary for an infectious disease, almost all of the commonly used antibiotics are compatible with breastfeeding

All **dental procedures**, including local anesthesia, teeth whitening, use of antibiotics and anti-inflammatory medications are also compatible with breastfeeding

**Ultrasounds, radiographs, CT scans and Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI)** are compatible with breastfeeding, even with the use of contrasts

**Mammography** should not be a reason to interrupt breastfeeding
